

## **GDPR information clause**

(1) The administrator of the personal data of the Participant of the INFER-PUEB Workshop on New Economics: Innovation, Digitalization and Revolution organized by UEP (hereinafter: workshop) is Poznan University of Economics and Business (Poznan (61-875), Al. Niepodległości 10), NIP 777-00-05-497, REGON 00000-1525.

(2) The Administrator processes participants' personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

(3) The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer overseeing the correctness of the processing of personal data, who can be contacted at: [rodo@ue.poznan.pl](mailto:rodo@ue.poznan.pl).

(4) Participant's personal data shall be processed in order to organize the Workshop according to the principles described in the Regulations, including:

a. registration of the Participant and realization of particular stages of the Workshop in accordance with Article 6(1)(b) of GDPR, i.e. activities realized in order to fulfill the terms and conditions of the agreement (Workshop Rules specified at <http://neweconomics.ue.poznan.pl/>),

b. claim and defense of claims in accordance with Article 6(1)(c) of GDPR, i.e. performance of legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator.

(5) Participants' data will be processed for the time necessary to achieve the purpose for which they were collected, but no longer than 18 months counted from the day of the official end of the Workshop.

(6) Personal data shall be transferred by the Administrator only to trusted entities, such as:

a. companies providing and operating selected IT systems and solutions,

b. entities providing postal and courier services,

c. scientific journals' offices.

(7) Participant's data will be transferred outside the European Economic Area and to international organizations.

(8) The participant has the right to access, correct, delete, limit processing, transfer and object to the personal data.

(9) The participant has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority for the protection of personal data, that is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

(10) Participant's personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

(11) Providing personal data by the Entrant is not obligatory, although necessary to participate in the Workshop.

(12) The administrator reserves the right to publish the Entrant's personal data (name, surname, image, affiliation) on the PUEB website, which is owned by the Poznań University of Economics and Business.
